The aim of this conference is to analyse the relations between the Apostolic See and the new political realities emerging in Europe in the first half of the twelfth century. The idea is to tackle the so-called "peripheries" through the often-overlooked point of view of Rome and to consider both the centre (the Apostolic See) and these kingdoms as "works in progress", always looking for opportunities to be acknowledged. This approach will also help in highlighting how external institutions contributed to the elaboration of the Roman primacy.
